All programs are held at Camp Rising Sun: Facilities at Camp Rising Sun are handicapped-accessible, including the 18-person cabins with showers and restrooms.

LOVING SERVICE (KARMA YOGA): You will be asked to sign up to be in service for about 2 or 3 camp tasks. For those who choose to opt out of this sacred communal opportunity, there is an additional fee of \$30 per day or \$100 for the entire camp, payable with registration.

WHAT TO BRING: Bedding (sleeping bag or twin bed sheets, blankets, pillow); camp chair/floor pillow; towels; toiletry & shower supplies; bug spray; life jackets and swim suits; talent show props; warm clothing for the cool nights; flashlight; rain gear; medications and inhalers. Some campers like to bring extra sheets to create privacy curtains.

WHAT TO LEAVE BEHIND: Scented anything. Some people may have uncomfortable reactions.

PRE-CAMP RETREAT: Friday, 3-5 p.m. Music, Zikr (Remembrance), Walks and Meditation to set the intentions for camp. A extra \$20 Love Donation is requested but not required. Check into camp & register by 2:00 PM if you plan to attend.
